Mekorama Puzzling Mechanical Dioramas

With MEKORAMA, kids start as players, unlocking one puzzle at a time. The objective is to guide the robot to climb and maneuver through the block-style structure to the ending red dot. The app comes with 50 puzzle cards for players to complete, but they can also find more puzzles created by other players through social media and download those by scanning the QR code on the card, or players can create their own puzzles and share them via the QR codes.

Leonardo Di Ser Piero Da Vinci (April 15, 1452 – May 2, 1519)


