Dear Parents and Students,

I am sending this letter to inform you that the Senior School will be opening its doors to students on Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July.

On this day, students in 1YL-4YL will spend the first period with their Form Teachers. Students in 5YL and 6YL will have Year Group assemblies with their respective Head of Year. The 5YL assembly will be in the Gymnasium and the 6YL assembly will take place in the Auditorium.

It has been a while since our students have been at School, therefore I would like to remind you of some of the most important protocols and expectations. Please take some time to review this information with your son/daughter.

### **School Day**

- Students will be in School for a full day, from 08:00 until 16:00;
- Students are required to wear a facemask at all times whilst at School;
- Students should remain socially distanced at all times whilst at School, this includes during break and lunchtime;
- Sports Practices will commence from Monday 19<sup>th</sup> July. Click [here](#) to see the full schedule.

### **Entering and Departing the School**

- When entering the School premises, students should apply alcohol gel to their hands, and clean the soles of their shoes, utilising one of the various sanitising stations;
- 1YL-3YL should enter and exit through the entrance by the auditorium (The only exception to this rule is students that come to school

on a bicycle. These students should enter and exit the school through the main Senior entrance, as this is where the bicycle racks are located);

- 4YL-6YL should enter and exit through the main Senior entrance.

## **Lunchtime**

- 5YL and 6YL students that presented the corresponding permission slip at the beginning of the year are permitted to leave the School at lunchtime but must be back at 13:20, ready to start period 7 at 13:25;
- Microwaves will be available for students who would like to heat up food that they bring from home;
- GCG, the School's food provider, will be informing you shortly about the canteen service available.

## **Uniform**

- Students are required to come to School wearing their summer uniform, or the School tracksuit on days when they have PE lessons or sports training after School;
- During the cold weather, students are permitted to wear their School uniform jacket whilst at School, including during lessons;
- Non-School uniform jackets must be handed in at the School entrance in the morning and collected at the end of the day.

## **Covid 19 related protocols**

- If any student is showing Covid 19 symptoms, or they have been asked to quarantine for whatever reason, please contact Santiago Novoa ([snovoa@british.edu.uy](mailto:snovoa@british.edu.uy));
- Please note that online lessons will only be available for those students who are in quarantine and healthy;
- Online lessons will not be available for students who are in quarantine due to travel;

Estimados Padres y Alumnos:

Envío esta carta para informarles que Senior School abrirá sus puertas a los alumnos el lunes 19 de julio.

Ese día, durante el primer período, los alumnos de 1YL-4YL estarán con sus Form Teachers. Los alumnos de 5YL y 6YL tendrán assemblies por grupo con el Head of Year correspondiente. La assembly de 5YL será en el Gimnasio y la de 6YL será en el Auditorio.

Hace tiempo que nuestros alumnos no están en el Colegio, por lo tanto me gustaría recordarles algunos de los protocolos y expectativas más importantes. Pido por favor puedan tomarse un tiempo para repasar esta información con su hijo/a.

### **Jornada Liceal**

- Los alumnos estarán en el Colegio durante la jornada completa, de 08:00 a 16:00 hs.
- Los alumnos deben utilizar tapabocas en todo momento mientras estén en el Colegio.
- Los alumnos deben mantener el distanciamiento social en todo momento mientras estén en el Colegio, esto incluye el recreo y la hora de almuerzo.
- Las prácticas de deportes comenzarán el lunes 19 de julio, haga clic [aquí](#) para ver el detalle.

### **Ingreso y salida del Colegio**

- Al ingresar al Colegio los alumnos deben aplicarse alcohol en gel en las manos y limpiar la suela del calzado, utilizando alguno de los varios puestos de desinfección.

- 1YL a 3YL debe ingresar y retirarse por la entrada del Auditorio (la única excepción a esta regla son los alumnos que vienen al Colegio en bicicleta. Estos alumnos deben ingresar y retirarse del Colegio por la entrada principal de Senior, ya que los ciclistas se encuentran allí).
- 4YL a 6YL debe ingresar y retirarse por la entrada principal de Senior.

### **Hora de almuerzo**

- Los alumnos de 5YL y 6YL, si han presentado el permiso correspondiente a principio de año, pueden salir del Colegio a la hora de almuerzo, pero deben estar de vuelta a las 13:20 hs., listos para comenzar el período 7 a las 13:25 hs.
- Habrá microondas disponibles para los alumnos que quieran calentar la comida que traigan de la casa.
- El proveedor de alimentos del Colegio, GCG, informará a la brevedad sobre el servicio de cantina disponible.

### **Uniforme**

- Los alumnos deben asistir al Colegio con el uniforme de verano, o el equipo deportivo los días que tengan Educación Física o práctica de deportes después del horario de clases.
- Cuando haga frío, los alumnos podrán vestir la campera del uniforme dentro del Colegio, incluso durante las clases.
- Las camperas que no sean del uniforme deben entregarse en la entrada del Colegio por la mañana y recogerse al final del día.

### **Protocolos relacionados a Covid 19**

- Si algún alumno presenta síntomas de Covid 19 o se le ha indicado una cuarentena por el motivo que sea, por favor comunicarse con Santiago Novoa ([snovoa@british.edu.uy](mailto:snovoa@british.edu.uy)).
- Por favor tener en cuenta que las clases virtuales solo estarán disponibles para aquellos alumnos que estén en cuarentena y saludables.
- Las clases virtuales no estarán disponibles para los alumnos que estén en cuarentena debido a viajes.
