Dear Parents,

It has come to my attention that some students have been ordering food from outside caterers through the various delivery systems.

This causes two distinct problems. Firstly, some of the deliveries end up going to other houses in the close vicinity, sometimes more than four or five a day. This is extremely unfair on those householders and they are getting understandably annoyed and have contacted us to express this annoyance.

Secondly, some of these deliveries are arriving whilst students are in class and they are asking permission to leave the lesson to pay for the food, saying that they must leave because the delivery person is here. This is not acceptable, and the School will no longer allow students to leave class, nor collect food from any school gate. Furthermore, the School will not take responsibility for the payment. The end result of this would be delivery persons waiting around for a long time or leaving without payment. This is just not fair for the delivery people, who rely on swift payment to make a living. If your child loses the service because they have not paid, that is not our responsibility.

As was explained at the beginning of the year, students can either buy food in School, or bring their own. Moreover, food is now readily available at School with more variety and microwaves are now available to heat up food. Therefore, there is no need to order food from outside.

Due to these issues, the School has made the decision to not allow any further deliveries to the School. This will take effect as from tomorrow, Friday 19th March.

Estimados Padres:

He notado que algunos alumnos han estado pidiendo el almuerzo a proveedores externos a través de varios sistemas de reparto.

Esto causa dos problemas distintos. En primer lugar, algunas entregas terminan en casas vecinas, a veces más de cuatro o cinco por día. Esto es extremadamente injusto para los habitantes de las casas que comprensiblemente se están molestando y que se han puesto en contacto con nosotros para expresar su molestia.

En segundo lugar, algunas de estas entregas llegan cuando los alumnos están en clase y estos piden permiso para salir del salón para pagar por la comida, diciendo que deben salir porque el repartidor está aquí. Esto no es aceptable, y el Colegio ya no permitirá que los alumnos salgan de clase o reciban comida en ninguna puerta del Colegio. Además, el Colegio no se hará responsable del pago. El resultado final de esto sería que los repartidores esperen por un tiempo largo o se retiren sin el pago. Esto no es justo para los repartidores, quienes dependen del pago rápido para subsistir. Si su hijo/a pierde el servicio por no haber pagado, no es nuestra responsabilidad.

Como fue explicado al comienzo del año, los alumnos pueden comprar comida en el Colegio o traerla de la casa. Además, hay comida disponible en el Colegio con más variedad y hay ahora microondas para calentar la comida. Por tales motivos, no hay necesidad de pedir comida de afuera del Colegio.

Debido a estos problemas, el Colegio ha tomado la decisión de no permitir más repartos. Esto comenzará a partir de mañana, viernes 19 de marzo.
